

**MINUTES
CHANDLER CITY COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
MARCH 8, 2011**

- I. Call to Order/Roll Call/Establish Quorum** – Mayor Gene Imel called the Chandler City Council meeting to order at 5:01 p.m. Members present: Glenda Temple, Larry Pribble, Rick Evans, Scott Carver and Gene Imel.

- II. Consent Agenda** – Temple moved to approve the consent agenda as follows; Pribble seconded.

- III. Citizens to be Heard - (5) Minute Limit per Person** – None.

- IV. Consideration, Discussion and Action on CD Bids for the Cemetery Fund** – Temple moved to combine the two Cemetery Fund CDs at BancFirst for 1 year at 1.01%; Evans seconded. Temple-yea, Evans-yea, Pribble-yea, Carver-yea and Imel-yea; motion carried.

- V. Consideration, Discussion and Action on Adopting Ordinance 2011-02 Amending City Code to Permit the City Council to Waive the Prohibition Against the Possession and Consumption of Alcohol on City Property for Specific Types of Events** – Carver moved to adopt Ordinance 2011-02 permitting the Council to waive prohibition against alcohol for specific types of events; Temple seconded. Carver-yea, Temple-yea, Pribble-yea, Evans-yea and Imel-yea; motion carried. Carver moved to declare an emergency; Temple seconded. Carver-yea, Temple-yea, Pribble-yea, Evans-yea and Imel-yea; motion carried.

- VI. Consideration, Discussion and Action on Waiving the Prohibition Against the Possession and Consumption of Alcohol on City Property for Weddings / Wedding Receptions and Establishing Rules and Conditions for Such** – Carver moved to waive the prohibition on alcohol on city property for weddings and wedding receptions with the following conditions; Evans seconded. In order to obtain a permit from the City Clerk's office the applicant must hire a CLEET certified security officer or off duty police officer and must attach a copy of their CLEET certification to the application and must hire a licensed bartender and attach a copy of their ABLE Commission license to the application. Additionally, there is to be no cash bars, as defined by the ABLE Commission, and there shall be no alcohol service after midnight. Carver-yea, Evans-yea, Temple-yea, Pribble-yea, and Imel-yea; motion carried.

Consideration, Discussion and Action on Consideration of Blue Label Bartending's Application for a Permit to Allow Alcohol to be Possessed and Consumed at the Interpretive Center on March 26, 2011, During the Vonda Williams Wedding Reception** – Temple moved to approve Blue Label's permit subject to the conditions listed in Item VI; Evans seconded. Temple-yea, Evans-yea, Pribble-yea, Carver-yea and Imel-yea; motion carried.

- VIII. Consideration, Discussion and Action on Consideration of David Clovis' Application for a Permit to Allow Alcohol to be Possessed and Consumed at the Interpretive Center on April 9, 2011, During the Davis / Messer Wedding Reception** – Temple moved to approve

David Clovis' permit subject to the conditions listed in Item VI; Evans seconded. Temple-yea, Evans-yea, Pribble-yea, Carver-yea and Imel-yea; motion carried.
